United States

FEDERAL: None

The US federal government has not established a national administrative body for sport. There have been two pieces of federal legislation which have impacted on amateur sport in recent times. These include the **Educational Amendment Act 1972 (Title IX)** which attempts to ensure equality of access by women to educational facilities including access to college/university sport activities.

Secondly, [the United States Olympic Committee](#) (Citation: 36 U.S.C. Subtitle II, Pt B, Chap. 2205) which restructured American amateur sport. This latter act gave more authority to the United States Olympic Committee and the National Collegiate Athletic Association "to promote and coordinate amateur athletic activity in the United States, to recognize certain rights of U.S. amateur athletes, to provide for the resolution of disputes involving national governing bodies and for other purposes."

The Amateur Athletic Union (AAU) retains a role as an important "feeder" organization for youth sport competition. The AAU is the umbrella organization for over 58 sport-specific associations and promotes amateur sport for youth. Other

important players within the US sports administration are the sport-specific national sports associations. Two other key organizations include the [American Alliance for Health, Physical Education, Recreation and Dance \(AAHPERD\)](#) and the [President's Council on Physical Fitness and Sports \(PCPFS\)](#). Both organizations promote physical activity, fitness and sports with AAHPERD focusing on school physical activities and PCPFS on communities.

There is one aspect of international sport where the US government is involved. The US State Department's Bureau of Educational and Cultural Affairs maintains a position, [Director of International Sports Initiatives](#). This department plays a major role in coordinating the participation of foreign athletes and dignitaries attending sporting events held in United States. It also assists US athletes in their participation in large-scale competitions abroad helping to insure security and consular support. Other recent activity 2000-2002 is the passage of the Physical Education for Progress Act (PEP Act).
